The IW analyzers also have very intuitive and easy to use sweep analysis, (including the ability to put the screen into a split-screen display for simultaneous broad span sweeps and a zoomed-in view), spectral image printout capability, and extended logging and playback capability. The IW analyzers are sold as complete kits which include a built-in rechargeable battery pack, AC adaptor/charger, multiple antennas, and a quick USB to PC connection, all enclosed in a pre-configured, laptop sized, high-impact carrying case. As for affordability, the IW1800 (100KHz to 1.8GHz) complete analyzer kit is only \$1,495.

Mark Kaltman, president of Kaltman Creations LLC commented, "It's incredibly rewarding to know that within a sea of over 35,000 show attendees, and with over 900 exhibitors, our Invisible Waves product stood out and above the crowd.
